General: Built in Austria in 2006 and sailed to Thailand in 2009, NAYA is a beautifully built and maintained Wharram Tiki 46. The yacht has aluminium masts and booms, the latter fitted to improve upwind sailing performance. Dyneema rigging. A bowsprit was fitted in 2014 to tack an asymmetric spinnaker, screecher or Code 0. All instruments replaced in the last 5 years. New fridge. Boat has just completed a haul-out and servicing work completed, a full rub down and repaint and new anti-fouling. Over 200 days of labour. The boat is very clean and fresh.

- Meranti Plywood, Epoxy, Fiberglass (300g/m<sup>2</sup>)
- Decks in composite construction with insulating foam core
- 2 component PU Paint, all deck area with anti-slip
- slatted deck in Banghirai tropical hardwood
- Two hardtop bimini's fitted for excellent shade protection

Drives: 2 x independent switchable hydraulic drives with drive shaft, in the hulls
